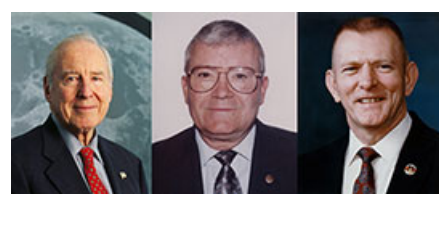

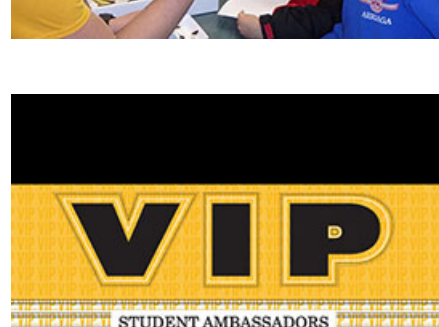
FHSU's English honor society presents writing at national convention
