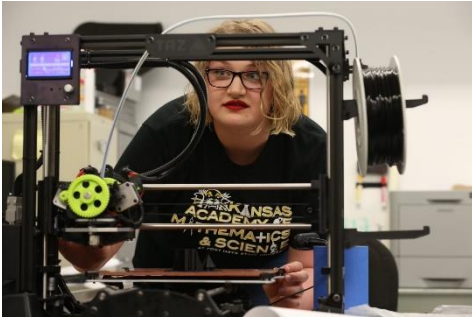
Two workshops will be offered during January by the Management Development Center at Fort Hays State University – one on organizational culture and another on social media marketing.
