## **Enrollment Leadership Update**

- Enrollment
  - Spring enrollment projections was 9,000 students. Enrollment report as of this morning, showed we are at 8,880 students. Graduate student enrollment is up 80 students. Both online and on-campus enrollment is down.
     International enrollment numbers are not included in the spring reports.
- Wrike
  - Make sure you are checking reports to see if they are running correctly.
- Story of Excellence Results
  - Year-end report produced each year. We report a lot of information, but are we showing how we close the loop. This next year, we are going to ask each department to come up with at least one initiative they have closed the loop on for the Story of Excellence.
- Updating Communication Review from RNL
  - Recruitment and retention and persistence. Broke out action items and asking areas for updates.
- Launching Marketing Review from RNL
  - Working with RNL to review the marketing structure of the University. RNL staff will be visiting campus in February and March.
  - Goal is to create a structure of consistency for marketing across campus focusing more on recruitment, but keep in mind retention is also important.

# **CampusESP**

- CampusESP is a parent communication platform FHSU has contracted with that will allow us to communicate with both prospective and current student parents.
- The goal is to turn parents into partners. Kathleen Cook is working on the implementation of the program.
- Different data will be provided to prospective and current student's parents.
- Committee will meet monthly to make sure we are getting the information out to parents.
- Plan is to share the platform at the SRPs.

## **Admissions Update**

- SRP Schedule
  - o First program is Sunday, January 28 in Kansas City and Topeka.
  - Each academic college will send a representative from each department.
     Each college will have 2-3 representatives. This format has worked out well.
  - Admissions staff, along with Joey and Dennis, will also host a Scholarship Dinner in Kearney, Nebraska on February 27 and Colorado Springs on March 2 and a lunch in Denver on Sunday, March 3.
  - Hays SRP is scheduled for Sunday, February 18 at 6:30 pm. Typically, 100 plus students and their parents attend this SRP.
  - This year, the University will be giving away a \$5,000 scholarship, \$1,000 scholarship, a bookstore scholarship, and three Victor E gifts cards at each SRP.
- Fort Hays State University Income Based Award (IBA)
  - IBA is a scholarship initiative from funds received from the State of Kansas.
     As long as a student meets all the criteria, FHSU will cover the remained of their tuition and award a \$1,500 Residential Life Scholarship. FHSU will look at each student's financial aid package to determine eligibility. Students only need to complete their FASFA.

#### FASFA Update

- Dennis thanked Chantelle, her staff, Student Fiscal Services and Tiger Tech staff for working on the two snow days to award aid to students for the spring semester.
- 2024-25 FASFA is open. The site is being taken down at times to make updates.
- FHSU will not be able to see a student's application until February.

#### **Spring 2024 Orientation**

- Due to weather, international student orientation combined with Student Engagement Orientation on January 12.
- Attendance included 30 domestic students and 25 international students. Over 30 students participated in the class crawl at the end of the orientation. Hannah is also meeting with students individually who were not able to attend.
