Academic Affairs Update

- Two new degree proposals will be submitted to KBOR and HLC for approval. The first degree is a BA in Religious Education and Community Engagement that will be reviewed at the December KBOR meeting. If approved, FHSU will be able to start offering the program in Fall 2026. Another program proposal being worked on is a BS in Financial Forensics and Fraud Investigation with a March 2026 timeline to be approved by HLC. The programs cannot be marketed until they are approved by HLC. Both degree programs will be available on-campus and online. Another program in the work is performance based on education. Learn while earning concept will allow students to work full-time in a school and use their experience to gain a degree. It will be launched as a pilot program.
