- Ordered, received, and replaced 36 back up adult electrodes for various AED units around campus prior to expiration date.
- Ordered, received, and replaced 13 pediatric electrodes for various AED units around campus prior to expiration date.
- Updated expiration dates of all electrodes and batteries on the PulsePoint AED app.
- Taught two CPR classes for two different departments as requested.
- Demonstrated the use of the AED and hands-only CPR to one campus academic department and one sociology course as requested.
