

2025-2026 AED Coordinating Committee Report

Description: The AED Coordinating Committee is responsible for checking University AEDs to ensure devices are ready for deployment, coordinating program efforts with the Ellis County EMS, planning and coordinating CPR/ AED classes, and reviewing and managing the overall campus AED program. The committee report to the Vice President for Student Affairs, is chaired by the AED Coordinator and includes building/ departmental AED Coordinators.

Key (Academic Year) Accomplishments

- Checked all campus AEDs and completed documentation of check a minimum of once a semester.
- Ordered and replaced 37 pediatric electrodes that were expiring.
- Ordered and replaced main adult electrodes and batteries in one AED that was deployed by Campus PD.
- Ordered and received two new Zoll AEDs and cabinets for placement in campus buildings. One Zoll AED was installed on the third floor of Rarick Hall. The other AED purchased is for the second floor of the Stroup Hall addition currently being built. It will be installed when the addition is opened for use.
- Removed and had reinstalled the AED in Tebo Library after its renovation.
- Taught one AHA Heartsaver CPR course at Fall Professional Development day – August 2025.
- Taught two AHA Heartsaver CPR courses as requested by the FHSU Foundation – November 2025.
- Taught one AHA BLS CPR course for the Speech Language Pathology program in the Communication Disorders Department – September 2025.
- Taught one AHA BLS Heart Code course for Communication Disorders faculty and staff – September/October 2025.
