- Email messaging was sent out to the Division of Student Affairs announcing events during International Education Week (IEW), as well as other cultural events encouraging participation in the on-line activities.
- A cultural display was placed in McMindes Hall by the cafeteria through the support of Residential Life to bring awareness to artifacts and items highlighting the culture of our international students. The display will be updated yearly.
