

Campus Accessibility Committee: The committee works to ensure that **all students have equitable access to campus programs, services, and environments**, while helping the institution continuously improve accessibility and inclusion.

Strong Service Delivery and Student Support

- Issued around 150 letters of accommodation to students with disabilities each semester
- Maintained consistent student engagement through intakes, consultations, and ongoing support
- Supported residential accommodations, including ESA and housing adjustments
- Achieved record usage of testing services, especially during Fall finals

Expanded Outreach and Campus Engagement

- Delivered presentations to students, advisors, and academic departments
- Conducted direct outreach to 7 departments, with additional engagement ongoing
- Increased campus visibility through tabling events, awareness campaigns, and programming
- Sustained and enhanced student programming (e.g., Tigers Without Limits) to build community and skills

Growth in Accessibility Awareness and Education

- Supported campus participation in initiatives like:
 - Invisible Disability Awareness Week
 - Disability Awareness Month programming
- Promoted universal design principles for broader student success
- Collaborated with TILT on digital accessibility efforts, including course content improvement

Strengthened Collaboration and Committee Development

- Expanded cross-campus collaboration with:
 - TILT
 - Student Government Association (planned involvement)
 - Faculty/Staff Ability, Inclusion, and Accessibility Committee
- Advanced efforts to broaden committee membership and representation

Identification and Advancement of Key Accessibility Improvements

- Elevated campus safety concerns related to pedestrian and vehicle interactions
- Identified barriers related to weather, infrastructure, and navigation
- Supported planned facility improvements (e.g., McMinderes ramp renovation)

Progress Toward Policy and Process Improvements

- Policy updates to align with current practices
- Planned creation of an Accommodations Appeal Committee to enhance fairness and transparency
- Identified funding opportunities (e.g., Chrisman Fund) for future accessibility enhancements
