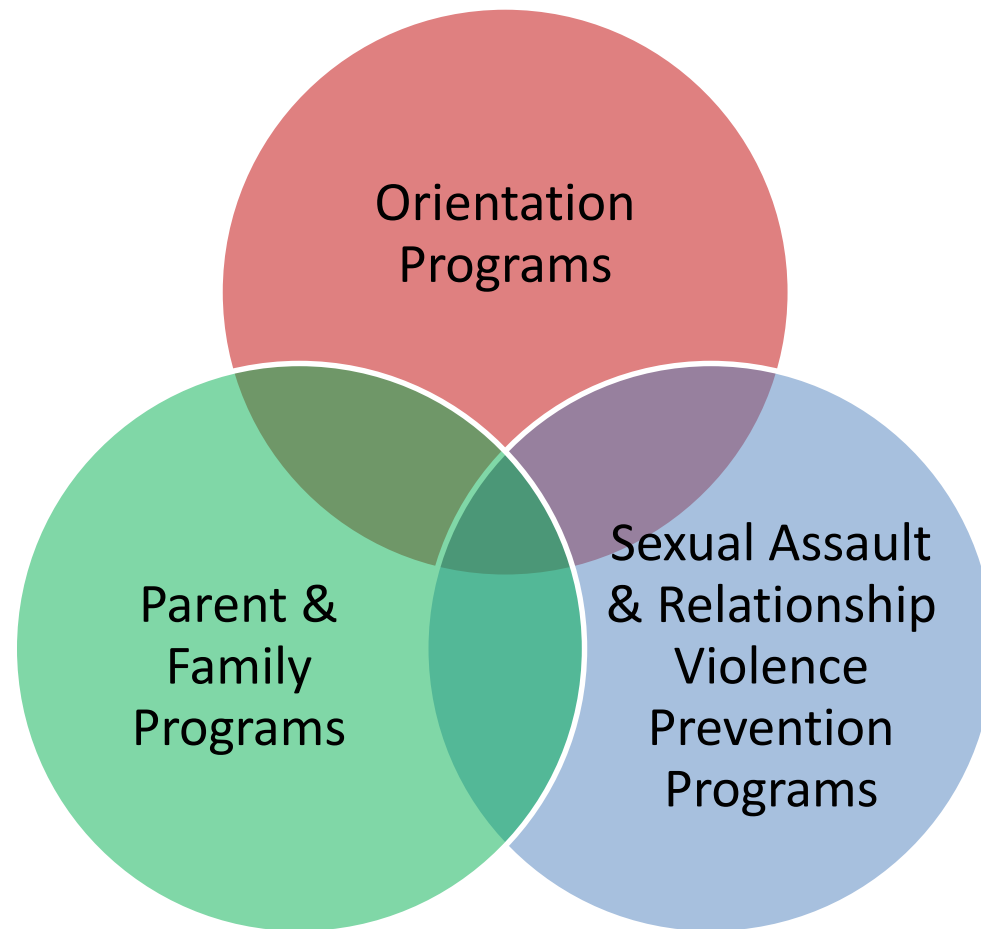


Learning Outcomes

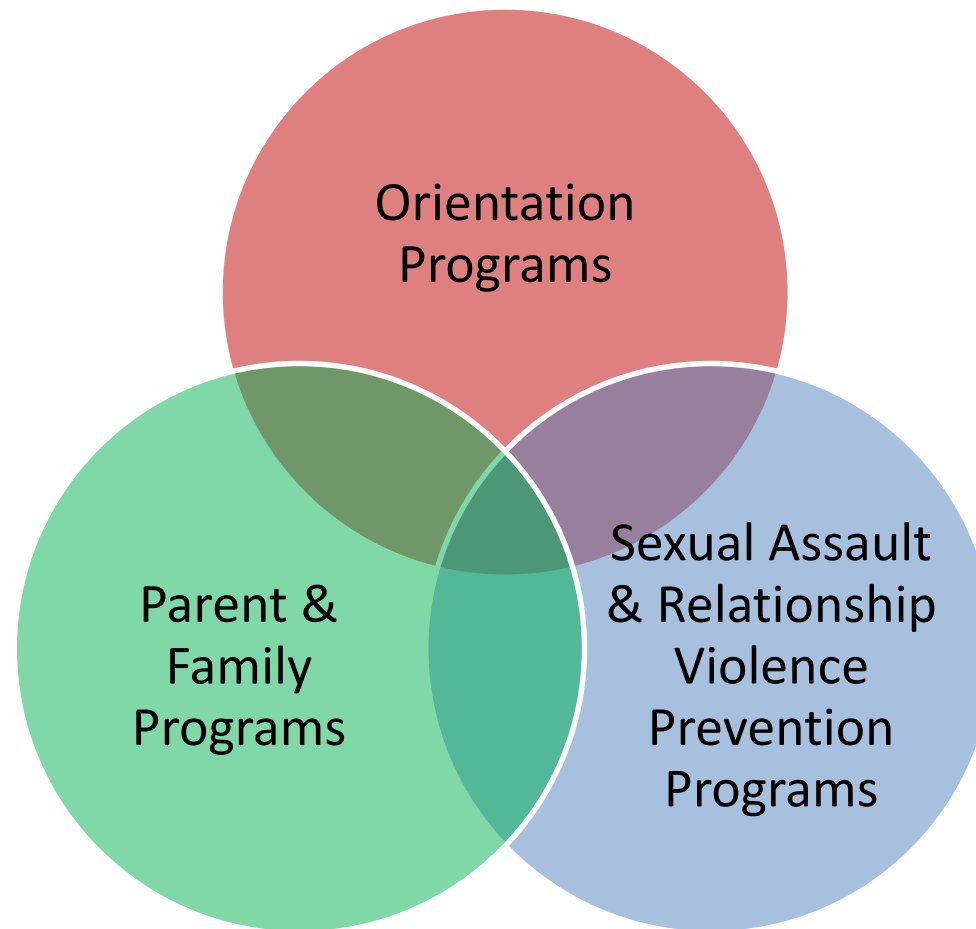


- Mission:

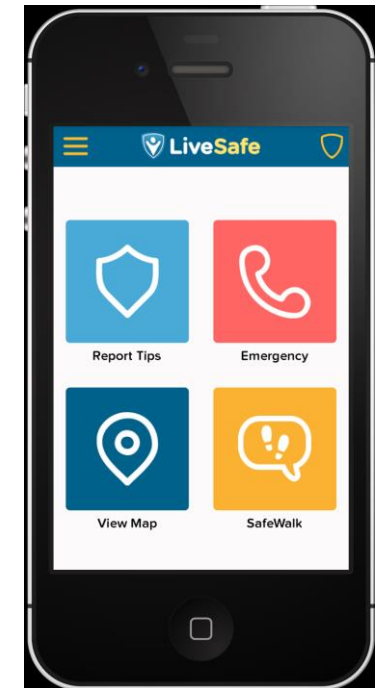

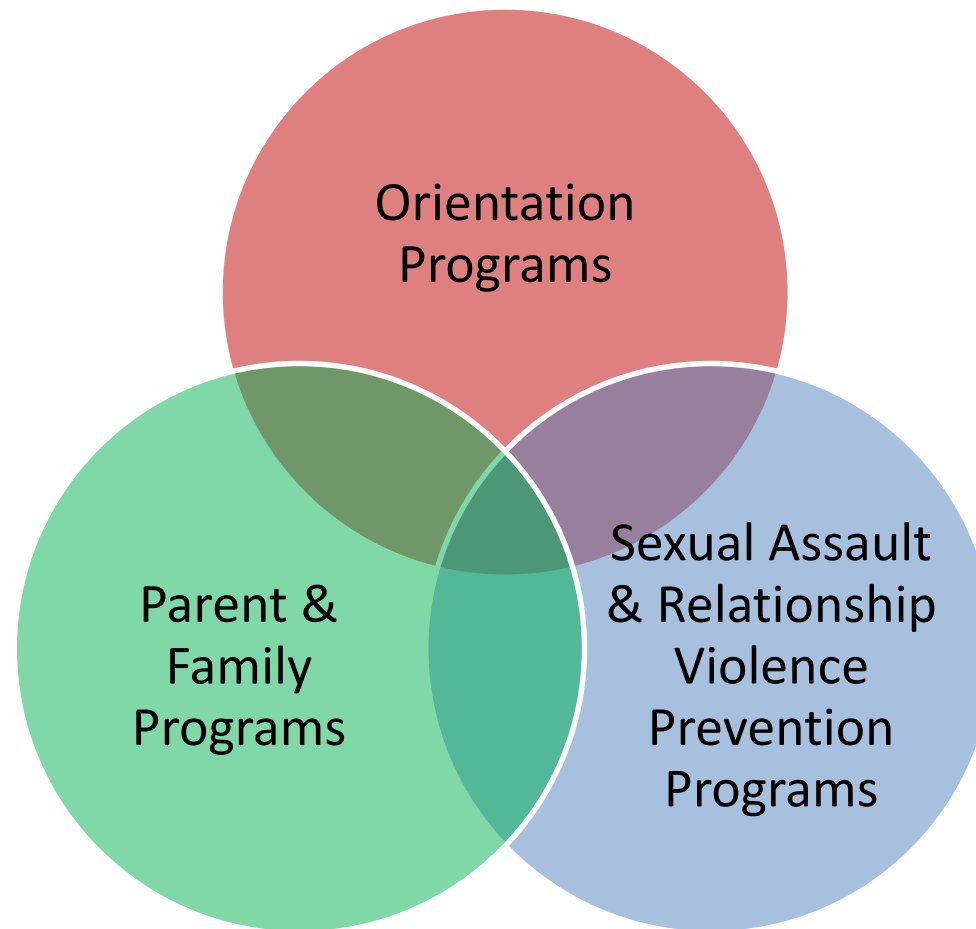
